

“Waynesboro” By Richard Bollinger



A water-color print of Revolutionary War General Anthony Wayne's Home in Berwyn, PA. The original was commissioned by the Paoli Business and Professional Association in support of The Paoli 250th Anniversary Celebration in 2005. Funding for the artist's work was provided by the Malvern Federal Savings Bank in Paoli.

Richard Bollinger began his career in 1969 and his work is represented in over 125 nationwide galleries. He was awarded the commission to produce the official commemorative painting for Valley Forge National Historic Park for the Centennial.

“Waynesboro” is a National Historic Landmark, home to 7 generations of the Wayne family, 1724 to 1965. The rooms, furnished with pieces from the 18th and early 19th centuries, have been preserved by the Philadelphia Society for the Preservation of Landmarks and the Anthony Wayne Foundation.

The cost of the print is \$100. Proceeds support both the PBPA and the Front Porch Trust, a 501c3 established in 2005 to provide scholarships to exceptional student volunteers from Great Valley and Conestoga High Schools. The print is approximately 24” x 15”.
